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EOD Updates

Bladder

- EOD Primary Tumor
 - New Note 5: Invasion of muscularis propria is divided into superficial muscle (inner half) and deep muscle (outer half)
 - Can only be made when a cystectomy is performed
 - TURB only:
 - Code 370: invasion of muscularis propria
 - Code 400: invasion of muscularis propria + distal ureter involved
 - Either code 370 or 400 based on pathologist/physician documents superficial muscle or deep muscle and there is only a TURB
 - · Cystectomy performed:
 - Only use Codes 200, 250, 300, and 350

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EOD Primary Tumor - Bladder

- Code 720 Extravesical tumor with extension to:
 - Abdominal wall
 - Bone
 - Pelvic wall
 - Pubic bone
 - Rectum
 - · Colon was removed from the list; colon is included in code 650
 - · No effect on previous cases both 650 and 720 derive D



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EOD Kidney Parenchyma

- EOD Primary Tumor
 - Involvement of Adrenal Gland (ipsilateral; contiguous involvement) moved to code 600
 - Removed from code 500
- EOD Mets
 - Code 70
 - · Adrenal gland (ipsilateral; noncontiguous involvement)
 - · Extension to contralateral adrenal gland



EOD Lung

EOD Primary Tumor


- Note 6: Atelectasis is the failure of the lung to expand (inflate) completely
 - If the atelectasis is clearly related to obstructing tumor code 450
 - If the atelectasis is clearly related to lymph nodes code to EOD Regional Nodes
 - If unable to determine code to EOD Regional Nodes
- Code 675
 - · Adjacent rib (contiguous involvement only) see EOD Mets for noncontiguous
- EOD Mets
 - Code 50
 - · Adjacent rib (noncontiguous involvement only) see EOD Primary Tumor for contiguous



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EOD NET Pancreas

- Applies to years: 2018-2023 (v8), 2024+ (v9)
- EOD Primary Tumor
 - Code 300
 - Ampulla of Vater (added)
 - Code 500
 - · All sites (subsites)
 - · Ampulla of Vater removed Found to be in the wrong code
 - · Head of pancreas
 - Gastroduodenal vein (added)
 - Body and/or tail pancreas
 - Note: Superior mesenteric vein removed, already included in "All Sites" (added)



EOD Vulva

- Applies to 2024+ (v9)
- EOD Primary Tumor
 - Code 700 removed
 - · Code no longer applicable in the Vulva schema due to changes in AJCC T definitions
 - New Code 650
 - Bladder mucosa
 - · Perineal body
 - Rectal mucosa
 - Urethra:
 - · Upper/proximal two-thirds
 - FIGO Stage IIIA based on extension

Note 1: Pubic/pelvic bone and further contiguous extension moved to new code 750



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EOD Vulva 2024+

- EOD Primary Tumor
 - New Code 750
 - · Fixed to pubic bone (pelvic bone)
- EOD Regional Nodes
 - Removed: 050, 100, 200, 300, 400, 500, 600, 700, 750
 - New Code 040
 - Isolated tumor cells in regional LN less than 0.2mm OR single cell or clusters of cells less than or equal to 200 cells in a single LN cross section
 - New Code 110
 - LN involvement and size of metastasis greater than 0.2mm but less than or equal to 2mm

EOD Vulva 2024+

- EOD Regional Nodes
 - New Code 120
 - LN involvement and size of metastasis greater than 2mm but less than 5mm or FIGO Stage IIIA
 - New Code 150
 - LN involvement and size of metastasis greater than 5mm or FIGO Stage IIIB
 - New Code 250
 - · LN involvement with extranodal extension (ENE) or FIGO Stage IIIC
 - New Code 310
 - Non-fixed, non-ulcerated LN involvement or FIGO Stage III
 - New Code 650
 - · Fixed or ulcerated LN involvement or FIGO Stage IVA based on LN involvement



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EOD Appendix

- EOD Primary Tumor
 - Code 600
 - Do NOT use for any appendix primary diagnosed 2018+
 - · Even though it is currently listed removing code 2025
 - · See EOD Mets for RLQ peritoneal involvement
 - SINQ 20230062
 - · Codes 700 & 750
 - · Apply to ONLY contiguous tumor extension to listed sites


Note 7: Codes 700 and 750 are used for contiguous extension from site of origin. Except for intraperitoneal metastases limited to the RLQ of the abdomen for mucinous tumors (see code 600), discontinuous involvement is coded in EOD Mets.

Strikethrough text is being removed from note in 2025

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EOD Appendix

- Peritoneal Metastasis (SINQ 20230062)
 - Changed from T category in AJCC 7th to M category in AJCC 8th and 9th
 - Effective immediately abstract peritoneal deposits in RLQ as:
 - EOD Primary Tumor code 500
 - EOD Mets Code 30
 - 2025 updates will correct for this via conversion for cases diagnosed 2018+
 - EOD Primary Tumor = 600 and EOD Mets = 00 to
 - EOD Primary Tumor = 500 and EOD Mets = 30
